Recently, I read an article by Mark McGinnis, "Leading in a World of Co-Creation". He uses the construction of the Chartres Cathedral to illustrate his points. He refers to two books by the Australian Architect, John James: <u>The Contractors of Chartres</u> and <u>The Master Masons</u> of Chartres.

Chartres Cathedral was constructed between 1194 and 1220. It is located 50 miles southwest of Paris. It was constructed on the site of at least five previous cathedrals that had been built beginning sometime in the 4th century and that were subsequently destroyed by "the lapse of time, the ruthless hand of ignorance, and the devastations of war".

There was no profession of architect at the time. "The role of architect and chief builder were combined in the person of the Master Builder, who was a skilled craftsman as well as a draughtsman."

According to James, the cathedral was built by a succession of nine masters, each building on the work of his predecessor. He explained that "... we don't know the names of the Masters of Chartres. Only their peers would have recognized their 'signature' in the distinctive details of the stonework they produced. This peer recognition—plus their pay and pride in their work—would have been enough."

So, as we enter a new year with new leadership, we will continue the work of our predecessors in the ongoing construction of our "cathedral," and continue the perennial cocreation of Lodge #7.
