Mission Statement

To encourage the pursuit of this goal, our scholarship program is intended to help to defray the cost to its members and their families in such a way that will allow this program to benefit eligible students in future generations.

Scholarship Rules:

- 1. Those eligible to apply are members in good standing of Flagstaff Masonic Lodge No. 7 or Grand Canyon OES Chapter No. 4, their children, and grandchildren.
- 2. All applicants must be admitted or currently enrolled in an accredited institution of higher learning. Enrollment must be full-time with the expectation of a degree or certificate.
- 3. All applicants must provide an academic transcript with a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 (C+) or better, either in high school (if applying as a college freshman) or in prior college or university level work.
- 4. Annual scholarship funding is dependent upon income generated by the scholarship endowment. The Scholarship Committee will review applications and award scholarships. The maximum scholarship shall not exceed \$1500 per academic year.
- 5. Applications must be received in the lodge by April 15 of the award year.
- 6. Scholarship recipients will be notified in June of the award year.

The Board of Trustees of Flagstaff Lodge No. 7 reserves the right to change these rules.
